Personal Social Emotional Development (PSED)

- I will work and play cooperatively and take turns with others.
- I will understand that my own actions affect other living things.
- I will be confident to try new activities and show independence and perseverance in the face of challenge.

Literacy (L)

We will use the books Jasper's Beanstalk and The Odd Egg as inspiration for our topic this term.

- I will break the flow of my speech into written words.
- I will segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together.
- I will use clearly identifiable letters to communicate my meaning, representing some sounds correctly and in sequence.
- I will write own name and other things such as labels, captions.
- I will attempt to write short sentences in meaningful contexts.
- I will read words and simple sentences.
- I will use words that are increasingly influenced by my experiences of books.
- I will enjoy an increasing range of books.
- I will know that information can be retrieved from books and computers.
- I will demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what I have read.
- In phonics I will be learning Set 2 sounds and blending 4 and 5 letter words.

Physical Development (PD)

- I will travel with confidence and skill around, under, over and through balancing and climbing equipment.
- I will show understanding of the need for safety when tackling new challenges and manages some risks. (Gardening)
- I will show understanding of how to transport and store equipment safely. (Gardening)
- I will travel with confidence and skill around, under, over and through balancing and climbing equipment.
- I will experiment with different ways of moving, jumping off an object and landing appropriately.
- I will show increasing control over an object in pushing, patting, throwing, catching or kicking it.

Mathematics (M)


Number bonds to 10

- I will explore different ways of making 10 using ten frames and the part-whole model.
- I will learn to represent 10 using concrete (objects) and pictorial methods.
- I will use number bonds to 10 to find out how many more?

Shape and Space

- I will understand positional and directional language to describe the position and movement of items e.g. up, down and across
- I will explore the properties of everyday objects, naming the 2D and 3D shapes I see and describing similarities and differences.
- I will identify 2D shapes within 3D shapes.
- I will explore, describe and compare the properties of 3D shapes.

Communication and Language (CL)

I will use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations.

I will respond to instructions involving a two-part sequence to grow my own plants.

I will create my own Bean Diary (sequencing the planting a bean using time related words and correct past/present tense e.g. days of the week, next, then, later, after that)

I will build my vocabulary of words relating to this topic by using books and the internet so that I can ask and answer 'how' and 'why' questions.

I will use talk to communicate my ideas and opinions about the things I read.

Understanding the World (UW)

- I will develop an understanding of growth, decay and changes over time by looking for <u>Signs</u> of <u>Spring</u>.
- I will show care and concern for living things and the environment by starting my own gardening project.
- I will make observations of animals and plants and explain why some things occur, and talk about the changes I see.
- I will enjoys joining in with family customs and routines by talking about why and how we celebrate Easter, inc Pancake Day. Why is it so important in the Christian Faith?

Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)

- I will explore colour mixing and learn about the terms hue, shade and tint.
- I will explore colour mixing with other colours (hue) and talk about how different primary colours effect the colour?
- I will explore the parts of a daffodil and use this to make our own observational drawings.
- I will explore floristry and make something special for Mother's Day.
- I will use tools and materials to make my own Easter crafts, e.g. Easter card and Easter Bonnet competition.
- I will join in with a STEM day to design, make and evaluate a project that will save Humpty Dumpty from his fall.
